Achieve **0.34** national income gap by 2030

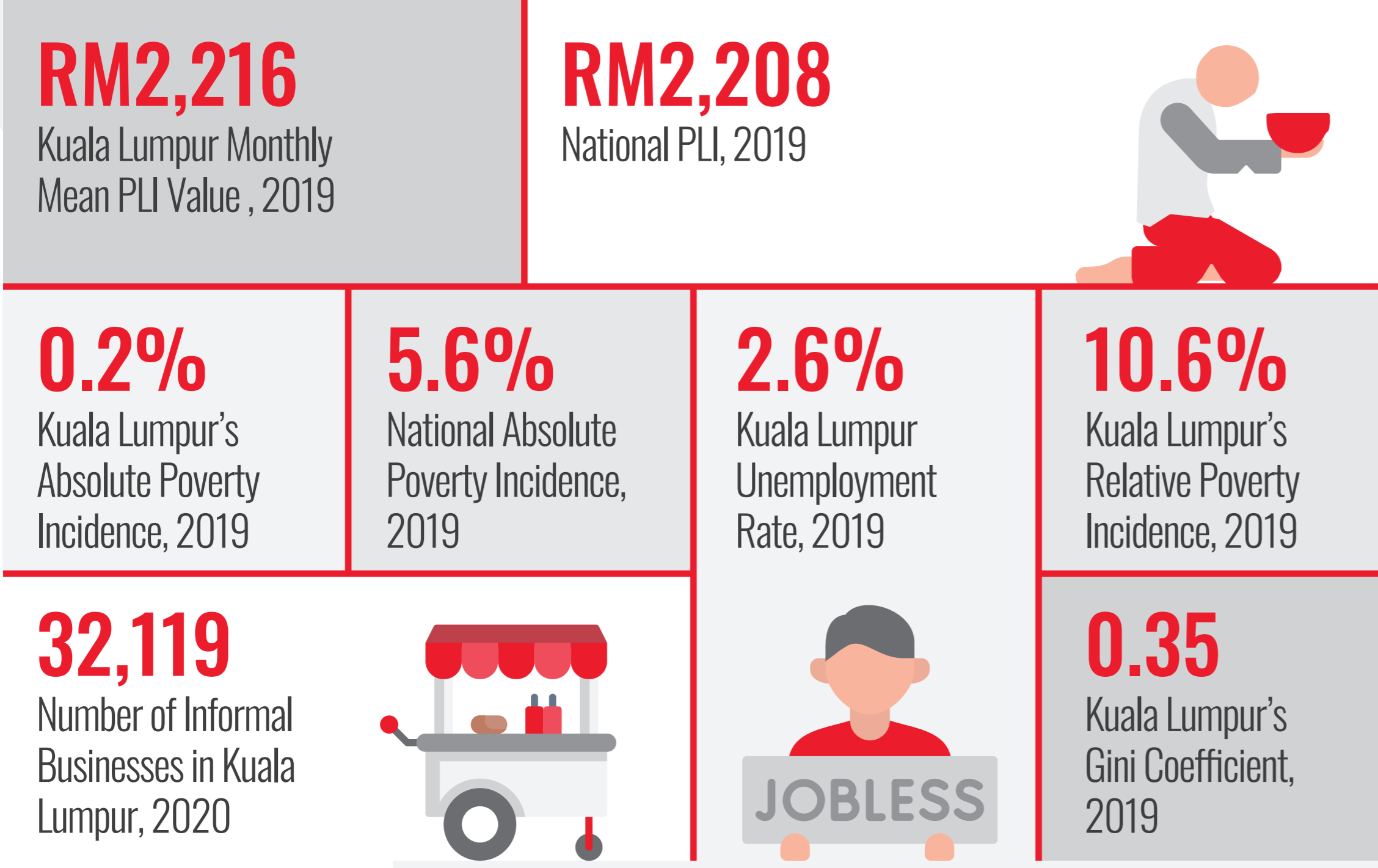

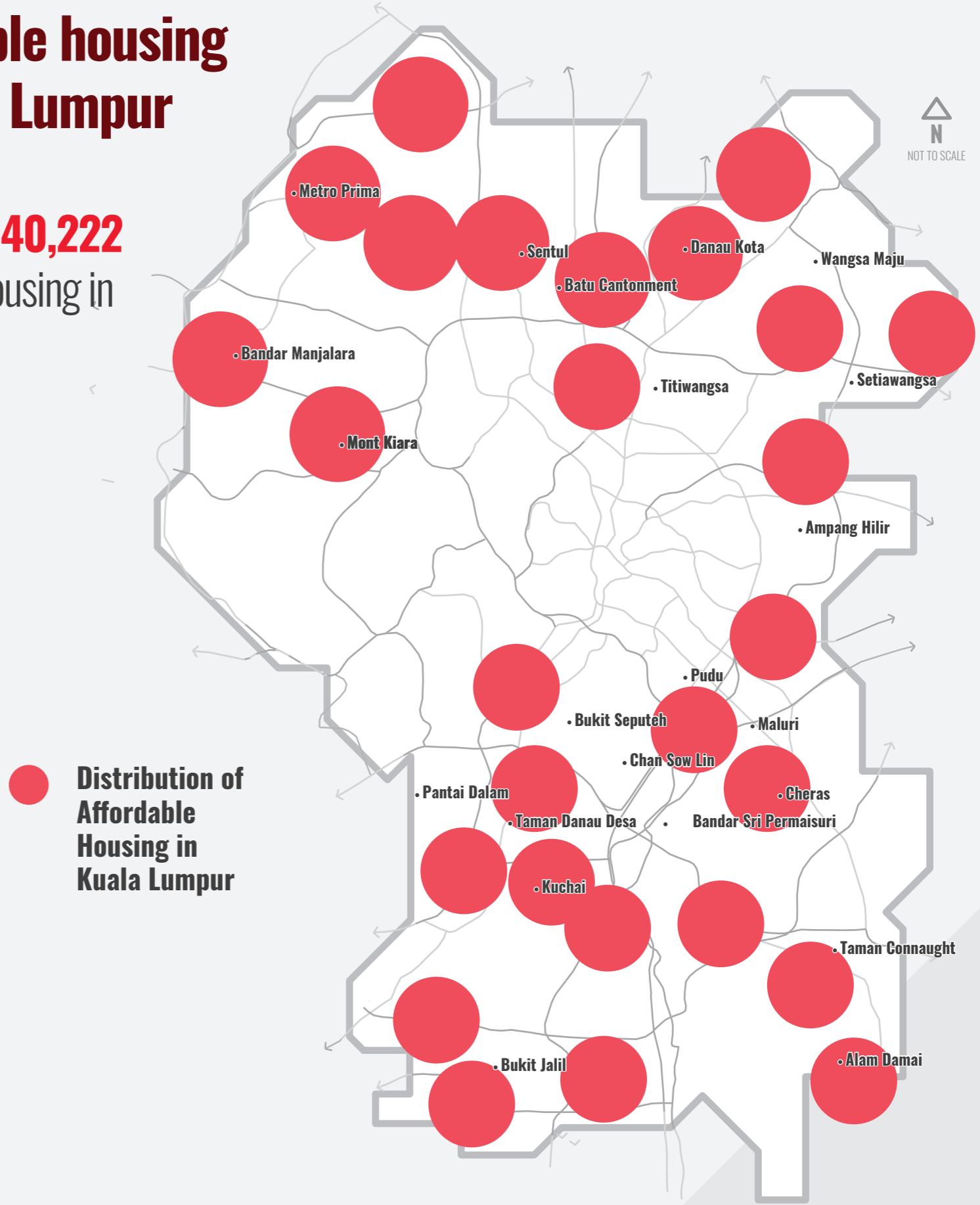
### 1 Households living under the poverty line
