

Collaborated with Malaysian Association For The Blind (MAB) This program is held to ensure the safety of the disabled (visually impaired) in Kuala Lumpur.





Kuala Lumpur Crime index was based on Safe City Monitoring System (SPBS) in the year 2017 to 2019. The data shows there's a declining number of crime cases in Kuala Lumpur by7.01 percent
