Improve energy efficient systems by application of Smart Operations for better System Average Interruptions Index (SAIDI) performance, power storage system, smart grid system and district cooling system



Recover energy from waste through development of Waste to Energy facilities that will be implemented at shopping malls, convention centres and key strategic locations



Reduce and efficiently use energy by encouraging low carbon buildings through application of resource efficient building technology and sustainable urban design buildings




Declining In Domestic Electricity Consumption

Current Kuala Lumpur has recorded a significant decrease in their **domestic electricity consumption from 4218.38 kWh** in 2017 to **1203.66 kWh** in 2019, a **71.4%** decrease.
